



Waco Agility Group Rules for Members, Students, and Visitors



Dog Rules

1. Dogs are to “relieve” themselves in the designated potty area. Fecal matter is to be picked up and disposed of by the dog handler. If an accident happens on the field, please clean it up as soon as possible. Use spray in the shed to clean the equipment or field.
2. No dogs in heat are allowed on the field.
3. Dogs that are people or dog aggressive may not participate in classes or work on the field. Dogs deemed “not under control” may be dismissed from class without a refund.
4. Mistreatment or abuse of dogs is not allowed. If it occurs, you will be removed from class or the field without a refund.
5. Students must be cleared by an instructor to work alone on obstacles. Do not attempt obstacles that have not been taught or practiced in class. Do not raise the height of bars on jumps above what you practice in class.
6. Only flat buckle or snap collars with no tags can be used on dogs. No training collars, electronic collars, choke or pinch collars are allowed on dogs. British slip leads, harnesses or martingales are allowed.
7. Dogs are to be on a leash held by a person (this also applies to the potty area) or confined in a crate or Ex-pen when they are not working. Only one dog should be off leash at a time unless directed otherwise by an instructor. Only one dog at a time should be on any piece of equipment.



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Field Rules

1. Field usage is a member privilege with the exception of students actively participating in PAF through Sequencing 2 classes who may access the field for practice. Following Sequencing 2 graduation (when students become eligible to apply for membership), students will need to become members to continue to have field usage outside of classes.
2. The WAG field and surrounding areas are non-smoking.
3. Do not drink alcoholic beverages before or during agility classes.
4. Wear appropriate clothing for running with your dog.
5. Children are not allowed on the field unless they are accompanied by an adult.
6. Please treat the equipment with respect and care. No climbing on equipment or fences.
7. Equipment or items used must be returned to their designated storage area which may be one of the sheds, along the fence line or under the covered area. When you leave the field, all equipment utilized, should be cleared except the contacts unless prior permission has been obtained. Water must be emptied from all containers to prevent mosquitoes. When leaving, be sure all field lights are off, shed doors are closed and locked, gates are latched and locked.
8. No VT's (NADAC video runs) are allowed at the field unless hosted by WAG and approved by the board.
9. Please be considerate of others training. Do not enter the field, walk to the potty area, etc., if another person is running their dog as it can be distracting to those training and possibly make your dog a target of unwanted attention.

THOSE UNWILLING TO COMPLY WITH FIELD RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE WITHOUT A REFUND AND COULD JEOPARDIZE THEIR MEMBERSHIP OR CONTINUATION IN CLASSES.
