NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will follow NADAC rules and regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

The Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook. Through submission of entry, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitors Handbook. A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded when available from the NADAC web site: http://www.nadac.com The May 2007version is under revision at the NADAC Yahoo Group site: http://pets.groups.yahoo.com/group/NADACagility/ under files.

- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions by handlers at all times.
- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC Agility Trials. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the Agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in control will be excused from the Agility trial. Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial.
- Bitches in heat are not allowed to compete.
- No refunds will be made for entries withdrawn after the closing date. In the event that the trial cannot be held for reasons beyond the show committee's control, no refunds will be made.
- Dogs must be registered with NADAC prior to entering the trial. Pending numbers will not be accepted. Registration forms may be downloaded from the NADAC website: http://www.nadac.com, and you can register online and get a number immediately.
- All dogs, at all levels, not jumping 20 or 20+ must be measured. Dogs with permanent height cards from NADAC do not require measuring. Bring your height card with you. Do not mail it with your entries.
- No leads, collars, food, toys, etc. shall be permitted on the course at any time, or within 10 feet of the ring, per NADAC rules
- All dogs must be must be on leash or securely crated when not in the ring.
- Waco Agility Group may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through the NADAC rules and regulations. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC or WAG will not be allowed to enter the trial (this includes those with outstanding returned checks).
- Entries must be made on the entry form included with this premium. Copies may be made. No other forms will be accepted. Entries must be signed and be accompanied by the correct entry fees to be valid.
- Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks old are not permitted on the trial site.
- No catalogs will be printed. Running order lists will be printed and posted at the ring gate. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as the class allows.
- Waco Agility Group, its board of directors, NADAC, management and the property owners assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, or children.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

Check-in Friday afternoon will be from 1:00 to 2:00 PM, with the first dog on the line at 2:30. Check in Saturday and Sunday morning will be from 7:00 to 7:30, with the first dog on the line at 8:00. You may set up Friday morning after 11:00 AM. Most crating is on dirt with limited crating on concrete. Because we are starting the trial on Friday, there will be no fun match Friday night.

Directions to the trial site (Central Texas Youth Rodeo Arena)

From DALLAS/FORT WORTH AREA: Take I-35 to the south side of Waco, exit 330 (Loop 340). Exit right and then right again onto Loop 340/Highway 6 access road and then take entrance ramp left onto Loop 340/Highway 6. Go approximately 1 mile to the Waco Drive (Highway 84) exit. Exit right. Go through the light for Franklin Avenue and turn left onto Waco Drive (Highway 84) at the second light. Stay on Highway 84 West and drive approximately 16 miles to McGregor. Once in McGregor, turn left at the blinking light at Brookshires/Conoco. Go approximately 1 mile and turn right on Bluebonnet Parkway. Go approximately 2 blocks and turn left into the parking lot for the Central Texas Youth Rodeo Arena (large metal building on left).

From AUSTIN OR HOUSTON AREA: You can take I-35 north to the south side of Waco. Take exit 330 (Loop 340) right and loop over to Loop 340/Highway 6. Then follow directions above.

Alternate Route From AUSTIN OR HOUSTON (VIA BELTON): Take I 35 North to exit 293A toward US-190 W / TX-317 / KILLEEN / FM-436 / FT HOOD. Turn Left on TX 317 and follow 317 for about 30 miles to get to McGregor. Just before you enter McGregor you will pass Dutton Drive on your right. The next left will be Bluebonnet pkwy. Turn left on Bluebonnet. Go approximately 2 blocks and turn left into the parking lot for the Central Texas Youth Rodeo Arena (large metal building on left).

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC no longer hand checks for discrepancies the records we send them at the end of the trial. Instead, they post the trial results to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after receiving them from us. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the NADAC Agility list and set your settings to "no mail". You'll be able to view trial results and find discrepancies (if any) without receiving list mail. Contact NADAC only if your registration number or qualifying results are shown incorrectly on the list. Otherwise, you do not need to do anything.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will no longer be banked by NADAC for future use. As of June 1, 2006 if a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.
