Welcome to the Waco Agility Group (WAG) Beginners Agility Class! We're looking forward to having you and your dog in our 9-week session. This letter should answer many of your questions about preparing for your first day.

### The Basics

Each 90-minute class meets weekly at our home field (see "Field Address" above). The full session includes nine classes and costs \$70. If a class is cancelled due to inclement weather you will be notified that day by phone and the session will be extended an extra week to accommodate the make-up class. Depending on the weather it could take nine or more weeks to complete the course, so please keep that in mind.

### Right now

First, please fill out the enclosed **Enrollment Form** and return it as soon as possible with a \$20 deposit. Deposits are nonrefundable but they reserve your place and are applied against the full cost of the course. Our Beginners Classes fill quickly, so we strongly encourage you to remit these now so we may hold a place for you.

### First day of class...what do I bring?

Besides you, your dog and lots of enthusiasm, you will need the following:

- The balance of what you owe for the class (class cost less deposit);
- Current shot records;
- A flat buckle or snap collar (no training choke or pinch collars);
- A 4-, 6- or 8-foot leash (no Flexi/retractable leashes);
- Soft, "semi-moist" training treats;
- Water for you and your dog.
