The Veteran division includes Veteran Dogs, Veteran Handlers, and Disabled Handlers.

The Veteran dog division is open to any dog age seven (7) years of age or older. The dog's age shall be determined by the dog's actual birthday, or the closest date, as known. Veteran Handler applies to any handler age 60 or older. The handler's age shall be determined by any piece of identification with their birth date listed. Disabled handler status is for any handler who has a certificate of disability. Handlers with a disability shall present a copy of their disabled parking permit or a letter from their doctor. If a handler wishes to enter any class as a disabled handler. Veteran/Disabled Handlers may not enter particular classes or a particular dog using the Veteran/Disabled handler status while entering a different dog or different classes in the other divisions. Dogs must enter the Veterans Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division after their 12th birthday. Dogs in this division are given the allocated Veterans course times.

Final Run Orders will be posted on the Waco Agility Group website by Tuesday before the trial.

ENTRIES WILL CLOSE PROMPTLY AT 11:59 PM – Friday, August 10, 2018. There will be no day of trial move-ups.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to <u>www.nadac.com</u> for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information. A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: <u>www.nadac.com</u>

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs or handlers will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$35.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <u>http://nadac.com/afrm/dogregfrm.asp</u>

Additional Information from the Trial Committee:

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry. Any dog which the judge feels is not in control or which exhibits acts of aggression toward people or other dogs inside or outside of the ring will be excused from the Agility trial. Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial.
- No refunds will be made for entries withdrawn after the closing date.
- Skilled dogs and breed exemption dogs need not be measured. All proficient dogs, not jumping 20 or 16 in the veteran or junior handler divisions must be measured unless they have a permanent height card. Dogs with permanent height cards from NADAC do not require measuring. *Bring your height card with you.*
- No leads or collars shall be permitted on the course at any time. Per NADAC rules: food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziplock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring.
- All dogs must be must be on leash or securely crated when not in the ring.
- Sentries must be made on the entry form included with this premium. Copies may be made.
- Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks old are not permitted on the trial site.
- No catalogs will be printed. Running order lists will be printed and posted at the ring gate. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as the class allows.
- Waco Agility Group, its board of directors, NADAC, management and the property owners assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, or children.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

AWARDS

Placement ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each jump height for each class and level, except Chances which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying rosette ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round. This is the first trial in our Fall Texas 2-Step Competition. Specialty High in Trial Awards will be given. There will also be \$1 coupons for all first- place qualifying winners.

VOLUNTEERS

Priority entry for a limited number of available spots will be given to exhibitors who volunteer to work. We will also provide snacks, water, and WAG Bucks, to all volunteers (as well as a sincere appreciation!).

⇒ Entry Fees:

1 – 8 runs = \$13.00 per run 9 – 20 runs = \$11.00 per run 21 – 30 runs = \$10.00 per run 31 or more runs = \$9.00 per run Number of runs based on all dogs living in the same house. Junior handler entry per run = \$6.00

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry, and there will be a \$35.00 service charge on all returned checks. Entry into future trials will not be allowed until all fees are paid.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the <u>http://www.nadac.com/forum/</u> within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to <u>http://www.nadac.com/forum/</u> and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members) and Waco Agility Group (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), and Central Texas Youth Rodeo Arena, (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
1.6. Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$35.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we agree to abide by the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the board of NADAC for this trial.
