JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20". There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16". Please see the NADAC Rulebook for the full jump height table

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to <u>www.nadac.com</u> for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. Only Intro and Novice handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry: 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers,

directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Waco Agility Group** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Bell County Expo Center (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FROM THE TRIAL COMMITTEE

- 1) Any dog which the judge feels is not in control or which exhibits acts of aggression toward people or other dogs inside or outside of the ring will be excused from the Agility trial.
- 2) Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial. No shock or E-collars or prong collars will be allowed on the show site.
- 3) Disruptive Dogs or Handlers will be asked to leave the building.
- 4) All dogs must be must be on leash or securely crated when not in the ring.
- 5) It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor or visitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELATING TO **CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19**

This Form must be completely filled out by each attendee and participant, including children.

The novel Coronavirus ("COVID-19") has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-toperson contact. Additional Covid Information

Please do NOT come to the trial if you have been exposed to COVID-19 or do not feel well! You will receive a full refund.

Following the trial: if you test positive for COVID-19 within 5 days post trial, please e-mail <u>Rena Bonem@baylor.edu</u> for that we call notify trial participants of potential exposure. Your information will be kept confidential.

Per the Governor's executive order, masks will be required in the building. If you are not able to wear a mask, please do not enter this trial for your own safety and that of others. There will be masks available You will be permitted to run without a mask but you must put it back on when you leave the ring. Please practice safe distancing by being at least separated by 6 feet from others not within the individual's group while at the facility. The individual's group may not exceed 10 individuals who go to the facility together. A group is defined as no more than 10 persons including the members of the household and those persons who traveled together to the event or facility." This means if you are traveling or crating in an individual group of 10 or less, you do not have to be 6' apart.

- 1. There will be gloves throughout the facility for anyone who wants them.
- 2. Course maps will be emailed to each competitor after 6:00 p.m. for the next day's trial. Course maps may be posted and you can take a picture of posted maps.
- 3. Results will be posted on the window at the hospitality room.
- 4. Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the arena. Pop up disinfecting wipes will also be available.
- 5. The Expo will be cleaning the restrooms more often. Blow dryers will not be used.
- 6. There will be no stands available for people to sit in, therefore allowing for more crating space and social distancing.
- 7. The leash runner will use a pickup tool that will be sanitized after each use or the competitor can run with their leash in their pocket or clipped around their waist.
- 8. Next competitor will not come in to the ring until the other competitor is on the way out.
- 9. Entrance and exit doors will be labeled. Please be courteous and use the respective doors.
- 10. The timer and scribe will be set up outside the ring.
- 11. We will limit the number of handlers in each walk thru. Please walk while the other ring is running and maintain social distancing.
- 12. We may use the microphone to announce next dog online.
- 13. One person will handle distribution of ribbons and stickers.
- 14. No food or snacks will be provided. No shared food i.e. no MACH/PACH, Birthday or Retirement cakes. The Expo plans on having the concession stand open Saturday and Sunday.
- 15. We will ask that only people competing attend, no visitors will be allowed unless prior approval.
- 16. No measuring of dogs.
